

Sark Stakeholder Evening hosted by The Prince's Foundation

The Seigneur of Sark, Christopher Beaumont, has invited The Prince's Foundation to help devise a long-term stewardship plan that will encourage investment in the island but ensure that its special character is protected. The exercise is being supported by the Sark Property Company.

Next week, four of our specialist staff will visit Sark to listen to residents and key stakeholders about the island's unique qualities but also learn about some of the challenges it faces. The Foundation will share their initial assessment in early summer with the hope of returning later in the year to produce a long-term plan for the island shaped by local people.

The community are invited to an evening event to share their thoughts about Sark with the Prince's Foundation team. In this drop-in session, we will record as many views as possible about people' views of positive and negative aspects. This will take the form of a series of informal conversations and recording information on maps and charts around the Natural, Social, Financial and Built elements of the island. This allows the Foundation to put together a very high-level sustainability appraisal and understand the variety of views and ideas in order to build a consensus around what future opportunities might be for the island.
